Whether you are a new referee who recently completed the USSF ELC class, became a new High School Official, or a Referee who has been officiating for years; take this opportunity to develop your skills and understand what it takes to advance. Joshua Bartel and Bryan Auten have designed a multi-path curriculum so you can move up the referee ladder here in Wichita. This is a FREE clinic sponsored by WRSA, KISOA, and the Stryker Sports Complex.

## Which referee are you?

- **ELC First Timer?** Don't let your first game COUNT. If you are a brand new referee, come get some time with real teams and real flags. Work one-on-one with mentors to help with the basics so you can focus on the game.
- **Ready to center?** Have you done some 4v4 centers or have been an AR for a while? Learn about the basics of centering (positioning, whistle tones, eye contact, soft signals, using Yellow and Red cards, and more).
- I want better games! Been a center for a while, but you feel stuck? Learn about anticipating play, advanced positioning, hand signals, and other tools. These are some of the skills required to become a collegiate official.

There will be several volunteers and stations for you to work on the skills above. The clinic will be held on the Indoor Field at the Stryker Sports Complex on Thursday, March 21, 2019 from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. Don't give your assignor or DOO a reason to pass you up for advancement.
