Registration deadline:

U11-U19 on Tuesday, January 28th, 2020

U5-U10 on Tuesday, February 4th, 2020

WRSA registration forms are online to help teams eliminate the paperwork. All forms are found at the **Stryker website, www.strykersportscomplex.com**, under the Coaches page.

Team registration – online – all forms required to consider your team’s registration complete

- Team Application - team info & contact - enter team name to be shown on schedules
- Schedule Conflict - list dates NOT able to play, team name consistent with Application
- New Team Official – required for only NEW coach’s background check
- Waivers completed by Team Officials and Parents on behalf of their minor player(s)
- Code of Conduct - head coach is responsible for ensuring all players and parents review their specific code of conduct. Head Coach is responsible for completion of the Coaches Code of Conduct. Head coach's signature indicates they are responsible for actions of their players and spectators.
- Team/Club contact –update coach or manager contacts, not needed if no changes since Fall

Player registration – required to receive player cards and official roster timely

Team using online player application (Blue Sombrero, Sports Engine or Team Snap)?

- Yes, submit via email team/club Player Report by team or by club sorted by team
- No, team/club required to complete player forms (IF NEW from Fall) and alpha roster by paper.
- Proof of birth - birth certificate, passport, driver’s license issued by a federal or state government
Required for any player not previously registered for a sanctioned league
- Picture of player – required for all team officials and players U9 (2011) and older

Other registration forms:

- Player medical releases are required to be signed by parent/guardian and maintained by the team for each league game, tournament and practice. Fall releases will carry through Spring
- Multiple roster signed by head coach of Primary and Secondary teams and parent/guardian.

Payment of fees: (found at website – Leagues page)

- Credit card, payment may be made by calling WRSA office 316-260-1060, #2 (Lori) or #3 (Gideon)
- Cash or check should be brought to the WRSA office, payable to Wichita Sports Forum
