



## WRSA Spring 2021 Registration

Spring 2021 registration is now open! The following provides general information and deadlines to make your Spring season a success. Important things to know for Spring 2021!

- Deadlines are earlier to allow time for placement meetings and scheduling.
  - **U11-U19 teams**                      **Thursday, January 7<sup>th</sup>**
  - **U5-U10 teams**                        **Thursday, January 21<sup>st</sup>**
- A \$10 per day fee will be added to any teams registering after the deadline. **To avoid additional fees, complete the online team application, <https://strykersportscomplex.com/coaches/team-application/>** prior to your division deadline.

We are ready to set appointments to finalize player documents and fees. All documents are found online at the Stryker website, [www.strykersportscomplex.com](http://www.strykersportscomplex.com) – Coaches. WRSA office hours are Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday 11 am – 6 pm at the Stryker Indoor building. Other times are available by appointment. Email is the best and quickest method to reach us, phone calls are answered as time allows between appointments.

### **Teams returning from Fall 2020:**

- Team Application & Contact - alerts WRSA of a new team and provides contact information
- Schedule Conflict – required to schedule your team on or before the deadline – mark dates you are NOT able to play. Games will be scheduled on any unmarked dates.
  - Team in Fall? Please enter your Spring team name as you have it on your Fall player cards on both the Team App and Conflict.
  - Teams without a schedule conflict submitted on or before the deadline will have conflict submitted blank and games are scheduled accordingly.
- Do not need new Code of Conduct or Waiver for coaches or players if completed in Fall 2020.
- Only need New Team Official online form if your team has a new coach or manager, see New Team requirements for coaches and managers for requirements.

### **New Teams to Spring 2021:**

- Team Application & Contact - alerts WRSA of a new team and provides contact information
- Schedule Conflict – required to schedule your team on or before the deadline – mark dates you are NOT able to play. Games will be scheduled on any unmarked dates.
  - Please list team name consistent on the App and Conflict.
  - Teams without a schedule conflict submitted on or before the deadline will have conflict submitted blank and games are scheduled accordingly.
- New Team Official – 2 requirements for any coach or manager to be on the sideline and receive a coach card:
  - Background check – required if did not coach during Fall 2020
  - Safe Sport certification – required annually if not completed during Fall 2020
- Code of Conduct – Head coach is required to complete and is responsible for all players and parents' actions
- Waiver – completed by each team official on the roster

### **Player forms required for Spring 2021:**

- **New player from Fall?**
  - Proof of birth if not previously verified in Got Soccer – passport, birth certificate etc
  - Picture of player dated 8/1/2020 or later – head shot of the player
  - Medical release – required to be signed by parent and retained by the team
  - Playing on 2 teams, need a multiple roster signed by head coach of Primary and Secondary teams and parent/guardian.
  - Parent and player code of conduct – while only Head coach conduct is required, recommended head coach review each code of conduct with team and spectators or have complete online.
  - Waiver – player waiver is completed by the parent/guardian on behalf of the player if 17 or younger
- **Returning player from Fall?**
  - If no changes to the status, no new documents are needed. The Fall documents will carry over to Spring.

### **Payment of Fees (All teams):**

- Cash or checks should be brought to WRSA Office. Checks payable to Wichita Sports Forum. Mailing address is Stryker Sports Complex, 2999 N Greenwich Rd, Wichita, KS 67226.
- Credit Card – payment may be made in person or calling WRSA office at 316-260-1060 extensions #1 Richard, or #2 Lori.
- League fees for Spring 2021
  - **Team fees:**
    - U5–U6 \$670
    - U7-U8 \$700
    - U9-U10 \$835
    - U11-U12 \$915
    - U13-U19 \$1,100
  - **KSUSA player fees:** NEW players from Fall \$14.25 per competitive player (U9-U19); \$8.25 per recreational player (U5-U8)
  - **KSUSA coach fees:** NEW from Fall \$5.00 competitive per person
  - **KSUSA team official background check:** \$20.00 per team official
    - KSUSA fees are paid annually when coach is first registered. If paid in Fall, no new Spring fee.
    - Rule of thumb.... if the player has a card from Fall 2020, no new player fee for that team.
